


Sarah's mom wants her to eat healthy snacks. At the grocery store, Sarah helps her mom to buy apples.

Sam is trying to do his homework, but it is so noisy!


Other kids are talking and laughing all around him. The engine is loud and the brakes squeak every time they stop, which is often.


First Lindsay put the dirty clothes that were spread all over the floor into the laundry hamper. Then she put away the game of checkers from yesterday and made her bed.


Marissa shivered as she climbed up the long ladder.
